Appropriate

___ Does the activity selected reflect those of age appropriate nondisabled peers?

___ Do opportunities for travel exist within the activity?

___ Does the activity focus on the student's strengths?

___ Are the travel situations and expectations found within the activity similar to the student's peer group?

___ Is the student going where peers typically go and do?

Functional

___ Is the student learning skills, including travel skills that increase independence?

___ Is the student able to complete a task or activity, without someone else providing assistance?

___ Would learning certain skills allow the student to travel safely and efficiently?

Generalize

___ Is the student learning skills, including travel skills, where and when the skills are needed?

___ Is there an expectation the student will generalize these skills to other environments or activities?

___ Could the student use these skills across more environments or activities?

Social Relationships

___ Have social relationships been considered when selecting the location and activity?

___ Does the student have both the opportunity and the means to interact with nondisabled peers?

___ Will the activity provide greater opportunities to be included with nondisabled peers?

The Future

___ Is the activity likely to be used in future years or during transitions between elementary school to middle school, middle school to high school, or high school to postschool?

___ Is this an activity with the same types of travel opportunities that are likely to occur when the student leaves school or their current living situation?

___ Will natural supports be available? (Complete after Phase 8)

Parent, Guardian, and Student Input

___ Has the family had an opportunity to share their priorities?

___ Has the student had an opportunity to share his or her preferences?

___ Is there an increased probability the student will make choices, develop skills, or actively participate in the home if his or her priorities are recognized?
